On Friday after the show, the Kernville Mule and Donkey Days will be offering a JACKPOT roping (time permitting). We will be having a 2 for \$10. Jackpot will only be held if we have enough interest. Does not go towards points.

Camping is available on the grounds. There is a \$30 camping fee for the weekend. You may tie to your trailer or set up a picket line between trailers. We are offering stalls (if available) for \$25 a night/per mule, this includes feeding and cleaning. (We offer cubes, oat or alfalfa) **Please clean your area before you leave.**

There are motels (make reservations early) and eateries in town within walking distance. White water rafting/fishing/swimming is also within walking distance, so bring your swimsuits. Come early and enjoy the weekend.

KERNVILLE IS LOCATED ON THE KERN RIVER BY LAKE ISABELLA

From Hwy. 14/395 take Hwy. 178 west towards Lake Isabella, about 40 miles there will be a sign with an arrow pointing towards Kernville (will be a right turn). That is Sierra Way. Follow that around the lake towards the town of Kernville. Before reaching Kernville, there will be a sign on the right saying "Jake's Place" with an arrow, turn left and head straight into the arena.

From 99, there are a couple of different ways you can come depending on how scenic and how much time you have. You can come up over the Green Horn mountains. Go through Woody and Alta Sierra (hwy. 155) until you reach Wofford heights. Make a left turn towards Kernville. Go through Kernville until you hit the dead end road, you can either take a right or left. Take a right. Immediately you will see a building on your right that has Kernville population on the roof. Immediately after that hang a right on Gilbert Lane and follow that straight into Jake's Place.

From 99, you can come up hwy. 178 towards Lake Isabella, get off 178 and take hwy. 155 (Kernville Rd.) towards Kernville. Go through Kernville until you hit the dead end road, you can either take a right or left. Take a right. Immediately you will see a building on your right that has Kernville population on the roof. Immediately after that hang a right on Gilbert Lane and follow that straight into Jake's Place.

Then if those aren't enough choices, you can also go around through Tehachapi and come up Hwy. 14 until you reach hwy. 178 west towards Lake Isabella, about 40 miles there will be a sign with an arrow pointing towards Kernville (will be a right turn). That is Sierra Way. Follow that around the lake toward the town of Kernville.

Please complete an entry form for each animal or team. Be sure to include both the rider and the animal's (make sure it's the animal's **(REGISTERD NAME)** AMA numbers. Make copies as needed.

A \$2.00 AMA fee will be charged for each AMA class entered.

There is a \$5.00 drug fee for each animal or team entered.

All AMA classes are \$15.00

Pre-entries: There will be a \$50 office charge for entries received after June 14th, 2011

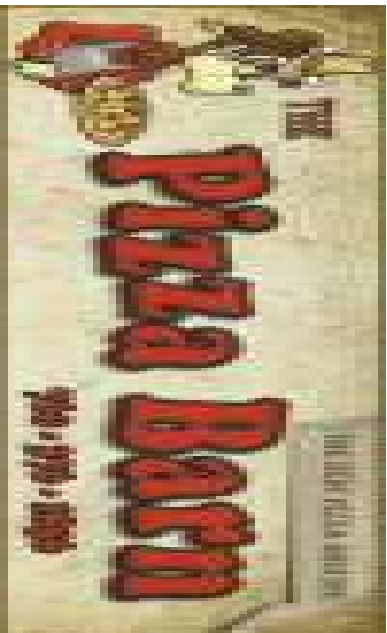
